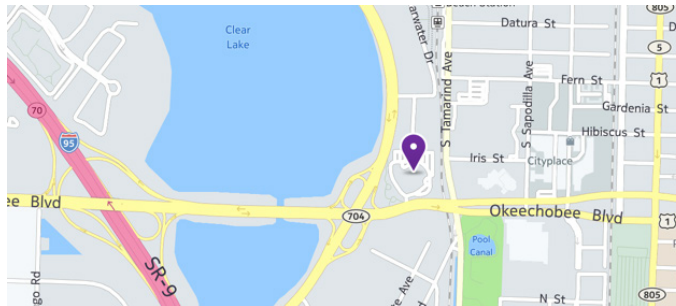

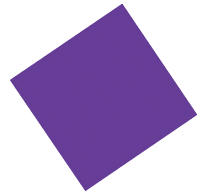

# PRESENTATION

This presentation utilizes an object relations approach to treatment of narcissistic-borderline pathology in individuals and couples. Case material and practice theory will be presented that identify narcissistic and borderline features and their clinical challenge to the therapist. Holding and containment with narcissistically wounded individuals and couples will be demonstrated, and use of the therapist's self examined through transference and countertransference analysis. We will explore therapist's narcissistic motives as an exercise for understanding unconscious process in the dyad and triad. The concept of triadic mental space will be applied to couples. Participants will be encouraged to offer case vignettes, comments and questions regarding work with narcissistic individuals and couples.

Carl Bagnini, LCSW, BCD is in private practice in Port Washington, NY, where he provides psychotherapy training, supervision, individual, couple, and family therapy. Carl is a senior and founding faculty at IPI and teaches in the two video-conferencing distance learning IPI Programs. He teaches at the Derner Post-Graduate Institute in Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy, Supervision and Couple Therapy. Carl teaches object relations couple therapy at the Training Institute for Mental Health in New York city.

His publications consist of 20 papers and book chapters and the book: Keeping Couples in Treatment: Working from Surface to Depth, Rowman and Littlefield, 2013.
